Athens Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship Application

The Athens Soil and Water Conservation District is offering an opportunity for college-bound agriculture or natural resource students to move toward their career goals. This scholarship program recognizes deserving students with a long-term career interest in agriculture and/or natural resources, and rewards them with funding for their college education.

## **Eligibility**

To apply for the Athens Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship, a student must:

- Be a high school senior enrolled in an Athens County High School
- Have an average to above-average academic record
- Plan to enroll in an accredited, nonprofit, vocational/technical institute, community college, four-year college or university that offers an academic major in a field related to agriculture and/or natural resources in the fall of the next academic year
- Plan on a career in agriculture and/or natural resources

If an applicant is in doubt of their eligibility, it is recommended to apply.

#### **Scholarship Amount and Coverage**

One, one-time award of \$500 will be awarded to a high school senior who meets the eligibility requirements. This award is good for one year and is not based on financial need. The recipient of this award is allowed to:

- Apply funding toward tuition and fees, room, board, books, supplies and incidental expenses
- Transfer from one institution to another and retain the scholarship

#### **How to Apply**

Please complete the attached application for the Athens Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship Program. Competition for the scholarship begins December 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. **Applications and supporting credentials (i.e.** current certified high school transcript) should be placed in an envelope and must be submitted to the Conservation Education Coordinator at the Athens Soil and Water Conservation District by the close of business on the last Friday of March of each year.

### **Selection of Recipient**

An impartial selection committee comprised of Athens Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisors and Staff selects the scholarship recipient in April of each year. In evaluating the applicants, the committee will consider their high school records, standardized test results, extracurricular activities and evidence that they are genuinely interested in a career in agriculture and/or natural resources. The required essays are an important part of the selection process. The top three applicants may be interviewed.

### **Scholarship Conditions**

Upon being awarded a scholarship, a recipient must:

- Enroll as a full-time student in the fall of the year in which the scholarship was awarded
- Complete the entire academic year without interruption, barring illness, emergency or military service
- Ensure that their scholarship checks are delivered to their chosen school

#### **Payment of Scholarship Funds**

Scholarship payments will be processed the first week of August. Checks are made payable and mailed to the recipient's chosen school.
